| Name                                | Description  |
|-------------------------------------|--|
| Pelargonium<br>'Lord Bute'          | Simply one of the best, if not the best. Big vigorous plant, long flowering and the most sumptuous flowers of scarlet / crimson edged with pink. Those who see it never forget it. |
| Pelargonium<br>'Covina'             | Attractive pansy faced regal pelargonium. Top half of flower is a rich mauve, the bottom half white. Very elegant.   |
| Pelargonium<br>'Angel type'         | We inherited this small flowered, angel type pelargonium a few years back. Not sure which variety by very floriferous – pink / mauve / purple blotched flowers. Good performer.    |
| Pelargonium<br>'The Boar'           | Zonal pelargonium with dark centres to the leaves and salmon coloured flowers. Free flowering.   |
| Pelargonium<br>sidoides             | A real stunner – soft grey green leaves and small rich magenta flowers – limited supply!   |
| Pelargonium<br>'More's Victory'     | Slightly unsure about the identification - inherited the plant under this name. Rich marked red flowers and fine cut foliage – a beauty.   |
| Pelargonium<br>'Lady Plymouth'      | The variegated form of P. 'Graveolens' – vigorous and great for adding contrast in tender bedding, pots etc.   |
| Pelargonium<br>'Grey Lady Plymouth' | Like P. 'Lady Plymouth' but with a more grey less yellow variegation.  |
| Pelargonium<br>'Graveolens'         | The classic garden scented pelargonium – soft pink flowers with a rosy / lemon scent. Tough and vigorous.  |
| Pelargonium<br>'Attar of Roses'     | Fabulous vigorous plant – soft pink flower and a simply wonderful rose scent.  |
| Pelargonium<br>tomentosum           | One of my all-time favourites – white flowers, soft furry leaves which demand to be stroked, a great minty scent and a vigorous, rambling grower.                                  |
| Pelargonium<br>'Radula'             | Like a finer leaved version of P. 'Graveolens' – I understand this is a good variety for cooking / flavouring.   |

| Pelargonium<br>'Cola bottles /<br>Torrento' | A strong upright grower with handsome pink flower – plus the foliage smells just like cola.  |
| Pelargonium<br>'Chocolate<br>Peppermint'    | A variant on P. tomentosum – has a chocolate splash on the leaf. Some say it smells a bit like mint chocolate.   |
| Pelargonium<br>'Deerwood<br>Lavender Lad'   | Small, lavender scented leaves. Magenta flowers.   |
| Pelargonium<br>'Clorinda'                   | Upright scrambling habit. Big showy mid pink flowers. Slightly cedar-like scent.   |
| Pelargonium<br>'Atomic<br>Snowflake'        | Interesting white edged variegated pelargonium – scrambling in habit with soft pink flowers. Strong 'pelargonium' scent                                  |
| Pelargonium<br>'Brilliantine'               | Small leaved variety. Pink / mauve flowers. Scent reminiscent of the haircare product of that name.  |
| Pelargonium<br>'Charity'                    | Golden variegated pelargonium with cut foliage and a pleasant citrusy pelargonium scent. Soft pink flowers.  |
| Pelargonium<br>fragrans                     | Wonderful small leaved pelargonium – delicate white flowers and soft leaves with an attractive pine-like scent. Small growing but very well worth a try. |
| Pelargonium<br>fragrans<br>variegatum       | The variegated form of P. fragrans – very attractive plant.  |
| Pelargonium<br>'Pink Capricorn'             | Showy pink to mauve flowers with a light centre. Foliage pleasantly cut with a slightly furry feel. Lemon rose scent.                                    |
| Pelargonium<br>'Royal Oak'                  | Vigorous grower with leaves shaped like oak leaves. Pink flowers with black markings – has an odd but not unpleasant scent – somewhat like cedar.        |
| Pelargonium<br>'Orange fizz'                | Orange scent, slightly coarse cut foliage with mid pink flowers marked with purple blotches.   |
| Pelargonium<br>'Sweet mimosa'               | Pale pink flowers, cut foliage and a sweet balsam / pelargonium scent to the foliage.  |
| Pelargonium<br>'Olga Shipstone'             | Small leaved variety with pleasant slightly fruity scent. White flowers.   |
| Pelargonium<br>'Lara Starshine'             | Quite similar to P. 'Graveolens' in leaf and scent but with larger rose pink flowers.  |
| Pelargonium<br>'Lemon fancy'                | Attractively serrated leaves, good citrus scent. Soft pink flowers.  |

| Pelargonium<br>'Mabel Grey'                  | Attractive deeply cut foliage, good citrus scent rather like candied lemons. Pink flowers.  |
| Pelargonium<br>'Grace Thomas'                | Very attractively shaped cut foliage, citrus scented with a pretty pink flower.   |
| Pelargonium<br>'Lavender Lindy'              | Small round glaucous green leaves with a good lavender scent. Purple flowers.   |
| Pelargonium<br>'Cy's sunburst'               | Form of P. crispum – small crinkly edged leaves on upright stems – amazing gold variegation especially early in the year – lemon scent.                   |
| Pelargonium<br>'Charmay<br>Snowflurry'       | Leaves marked with cream / white splashes. Citrus / rose fragrance. Soft pink flowers.  |
| Pelargonium<br>odoratissimum                 | Interesting small leaved species pelargonium. Has soft apple green foliage with the most peculiar smell – some say like spiced apples, others bubble-gum! |
| Pelargonium<br>cordifolium x<br>rubrocinctum | V interesting species type pelargonium – pink half flowers on a v tall vigorous plant – has grown in our glasshouse up to 6ft. Well worth a try.          |
| Pelargonium<br>australe                      | Low growing plant with rounded leaves – dark green in colour with a reddish / purple underside. Sprays of white flowers.                                  |
